14/11 Rockwell Wood Lathe with Duplicator \$800


Although this lathe was constructed in 1974 it is in excellent condition and runs like new. Includes metal stand with shelf and the following accessories:

Plan to Attend 2014 Creativity in Woodturning Symposium FEATURING RICHARD RAF-FAN

July 26, 2014 with Workshops July 27-30, 2014

Richard Raffan has been a professional turner since the early 1970s. Well-known for his impeccable sense of shape and form, and his mastery of the craft of woodturning, he was inspired by the influence of the English Arts & Crafts movement. Although he has worked with what might be considered more 'artistic' forms, Raffan is best known for his functional work, and prefers to be referred to as a craftsman.

Perhaps one of the best known woodturners in the world, Richard Raffan has always had a strong sense of the legacy he will

leave, and of the anonymous craftsmen who came before him. Around the time he started woodturning in the early 70s, all across the western world trade turners were laying down their tools. Raffan's entry into turning coincided with this decline of turning as a trade, but it was just in time for him to learn from a turner who still had the old skills. As the last generation of production hand-turners gave up the trade Richard was able to step into his role as guardian of a traditional craft and was able to pass on these skills to the rapidly growing numbers of new turners.

In great demand, he's given presentations, workshops, has authored many books, journal articles, videos, and DVDs, and designed tools. Although the authorships, presentations, and workshops are important Richard, the craftsman, prides himself on his ability to make a decent living selling his turnings.

In 2012 Richard was the recipient of the AAW Professional Outreach Program Merit Award.

"This award is given to an artist whose body of work has contributed significantly to the growth of woodturning as an art form. Richard is one of the best known, most respected, and influential turners in the world. This award is both a timely recognition of his own contribution to the field and an acknowledgement that a person who has devoted their life to turning as a craft can make as significant a contribution as those more celebrated for their artistic contributions."

The name Richard Raffan is synonymous with woodturning. Through Richard, many a turner has improved their skill and understanding of woodturning. One can easily say that Richard has shaped not only wood but almost every woodturner today that has looked outside themselves for inspiration and affirmation.

Richard has noted that 'he is drifting into his retirement years' (Raffan website) and has told us that he will not be coming to the 'States' much anymore. Could our 2014 Creativity in Woodturning Symposium be one of your last chances to see Richard Raffan in person? Don't miss this opportunity."
