We are pleased to announce that Trent Bosch will be our keynote demonstrator for our July 26, 2014 symposium replacing Richard Raffan.




14/11 Rockwell Wood Lathe with Duplicator \$800

Although this lathe was constructed in 1974 it is in excellent condition and runs like new. Includes metal stand with shelf and the following accessories:

- Two face plates 3" and 6", Four tool rests: 4", 5 ½" 12" and 24", Spur drive, Live center, Cup center, Ten woodturning tools, Knock out bar, Two banjos, Owner manuals for both lathe and duplicator Technical specifications:
 - Spindle is 1" X 8 TPI so all mini lathe chucks and other accessories will fit
 - #2 Morse taper
 - Over center turning is 14" at headstock and 11" over lathe bed
 - 34" length spindle capacity
