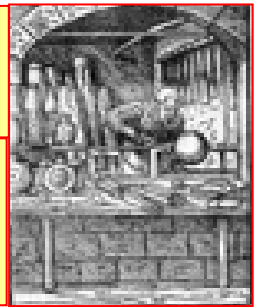
Next month we will be having a mini symposium and as usual we need more demonstrators. Show us what you do, I guarantee you will have fun.

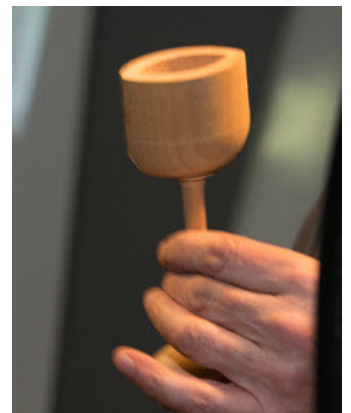
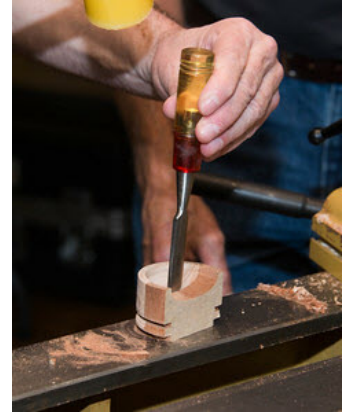
